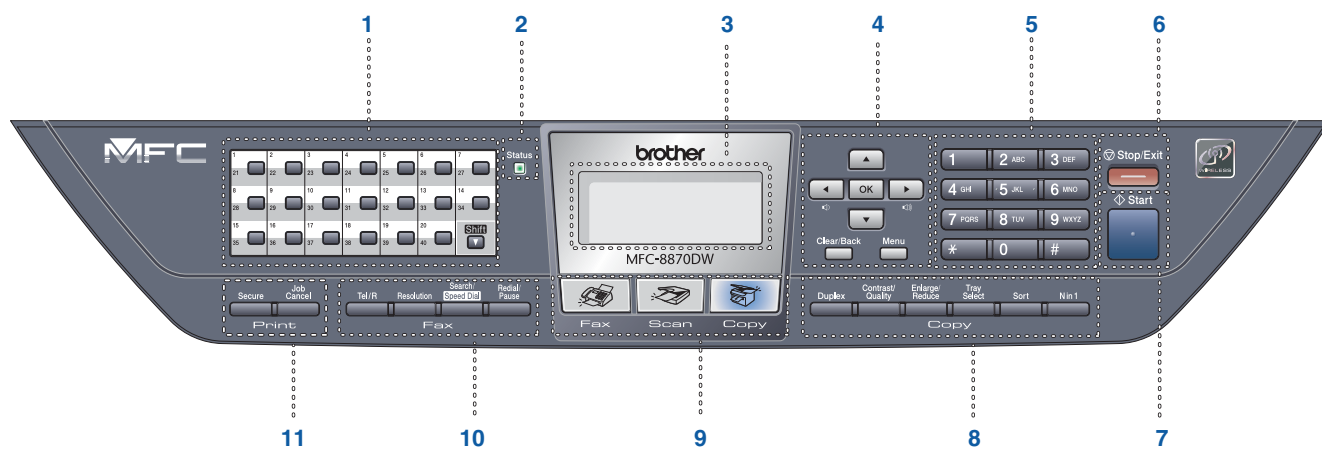
The interface cable is not a standard accessory. Please purchase the appropriate interface cable for the interface you intend to use (Parallel, USB or Network).

Do NOT connect the interface cable at this time. Connecting the interface cable is done during the software installation process.

- USB interface cable
Please make sure you use a USB 2.0 interface cable that is no longer than 2.0 meters.
When you use a USB cable, make sure you connect it to the USB port of your computer and not to a USB port on a keyboard or non-powered USB hub.
- Parallel interface cable
Please make sure you use a Parallel interface cable that is no longer than 2.0 meters.
Use a shielded interface cable that is IEEE 1284-compliant.
- Network cable
Use a straight-through Category5 (or greater) twisted-pair cable for 10BASE-T or 100Base-TX Fast Ethernet Network.

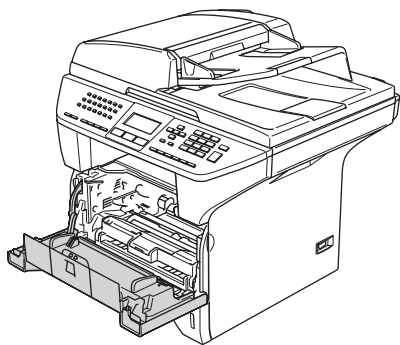
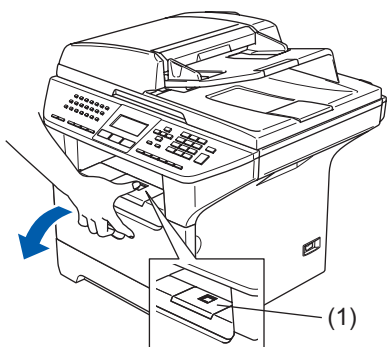
1 Install the drum and toner cartridge unit assembly

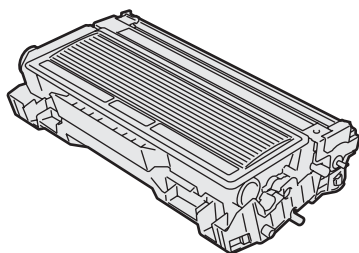
DO NOT connect the interface cable.

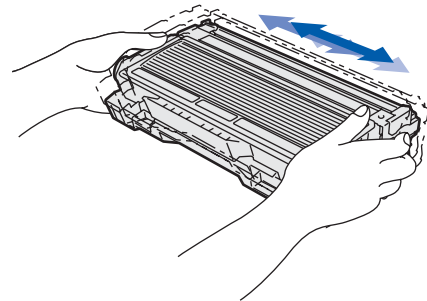
- 1** Open the front cover by pressing the front cover release button (1).



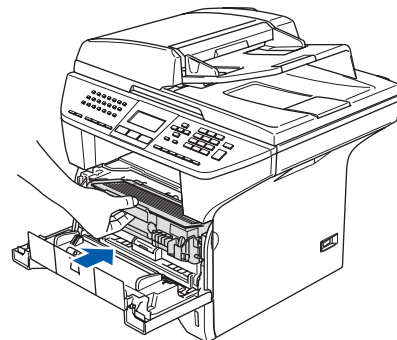
- 2** Unpack the drum and toner cartridge unit assembly.



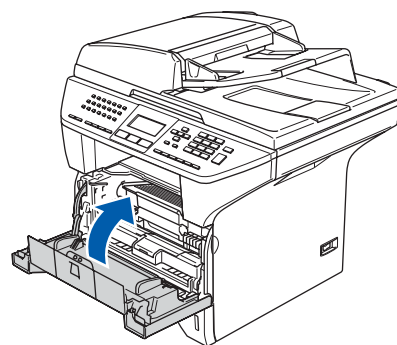
- 3** Gently rock it from side to side several times to distribute the toner evenly inside the assembly.



- 4** Put the drum unit assembly into the machine until it clicks into place.

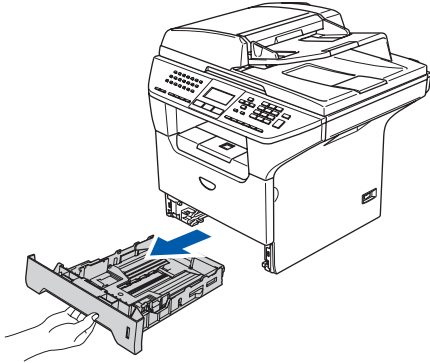


- 5** Close the front cover of the machine.

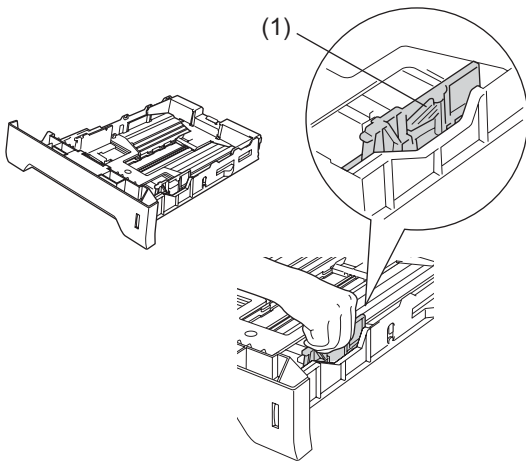


2 Load paper in the paper tray

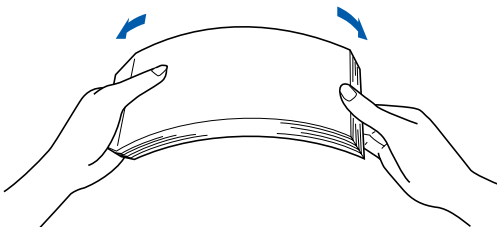
- 1** Pull the paper tray completely out of the machine.



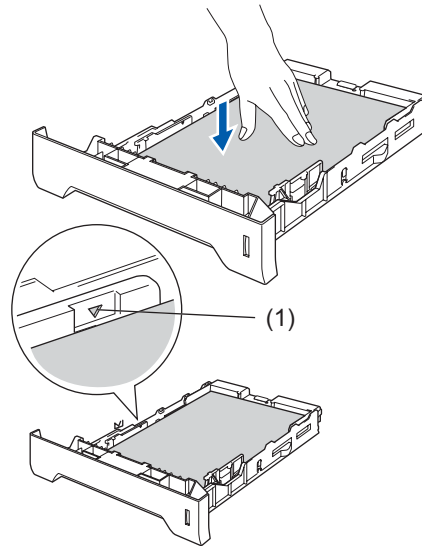
- 2** While pressing the blue paper guide release lever (1), slide the adjusters to fit the paper size. Check that the guides are firmly in the slots.



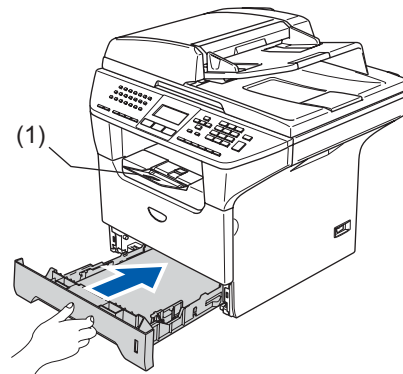
- 3** Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.



- 4** Put paper in the paper tray. Check that the paper is flat in the tray and below the maximum paper mark (1).



- 5** Put the paper tray firmly back into the machine and unfold the output tray support flap (1) before you use the machine.

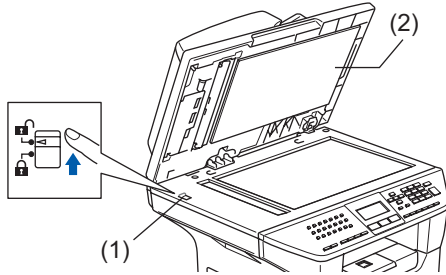

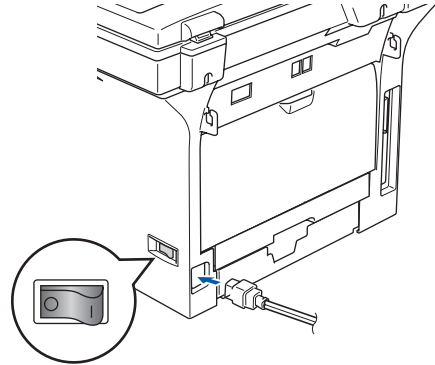
3 Release the scanner lock

- 1 Push the lever (1) in the direction shown to unlock the scanner.
(The grey scanner lock lever is located at the back left side, under the document cover (2).)



4 Install the power cord and phone line

- 1 Make sure that the machine power switch is off. Connect the AC power cord to the machine.



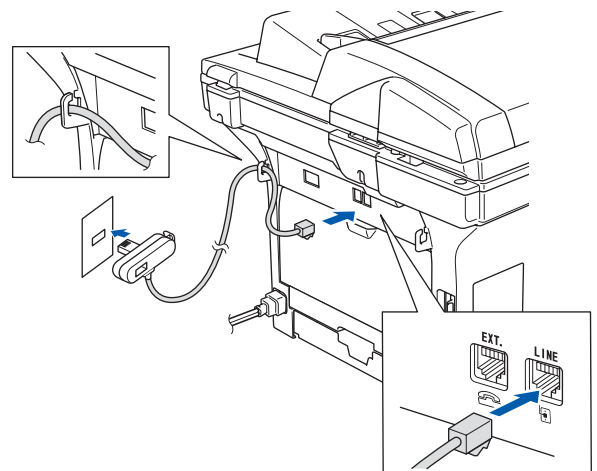
- 2 Plug the AC power cord into an AC outlet. Turn the power switch on.



Note

*If **Scanner Locked** appears on the LCD, immediately release the scanner lock and press **Stop/Exit**. (See "3. Release the scanner lock".)*

- 3 Connect one end of the telephone line cord to the socket on the machine marked **LINE** and the other end to a modular wall socket.

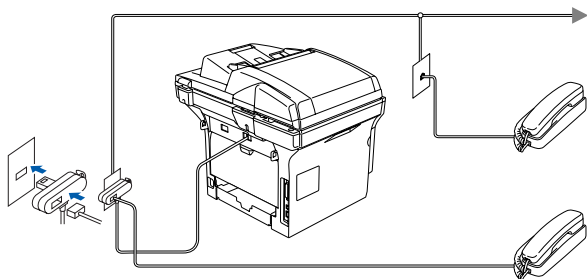


Warning

- The machine must be fitted with an earthed plug.
- Since the machine is grounded through the power outlet, you can protect yourself from potentially hazardous electrical conditions on the telephone network by keeping the power cord connected to your machine when you connect it to a telephone line. Similarly, you can protect yourself when you want to move your machine by disconnecting the telephone line first and then the power cord.

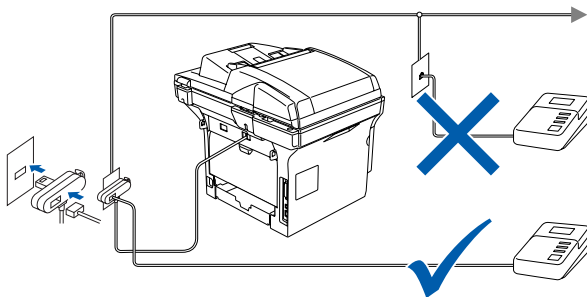

5 Setting the date and time

The machine displays the date and time, and if you setup the station ID, the date and time will print on every fax you send.

- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press **0**.
- 3 Press **2**.
- 4 Enter the last two digits of the year on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

(e.g. Enter **0, 6** for 2006.)

- 5 Enter the two digits for the month on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

- 6 Enter the two digits for the day on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

- 7 Enter the time in 24-hour format on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

(e.g. Enter **1, 5, 2, 5** for 3:25 P.M.)

- 8 Press **Stop/Exit**.

*If you make a mistake, press **Stop/Exit** to start from step 1.*

6 Setting your station ID

You should store your name and fax number to be printed on all fax pages that you send.

- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press **0**.
- 3 Press **3**.
- 4 Enter your fax number (up to 20 digits) on the dial pad, and then press **OK**. To enter a "+" for international dialling codes, press *****. For example, to enter the UK dialling code "+44", press *****, **4**, **4**, and then rest of your number.

7 Tone and pulse dialling mode

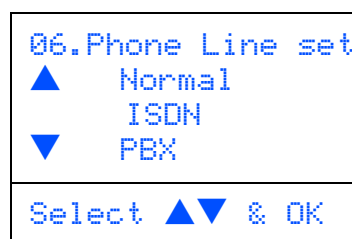
Your machine comes set for Tone dialling service. If you have Pulse dialling service (rotary), you need to change the dialling mode.

- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press **0**.
- 3 Press **4**.
- 4 Press  or  to choose Pulse (or Tone). Press **OK**.
- 5 Press **Stop/Exit**.

8 Setting the phone line type

If you are connecting the machine to a line that features a PABX (PBX) or ISDN to send and receive faxes, it is necessary to change the Phone Line Type accordingly by completing the following steps.

- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press **0**.
- 3 Press **6**.
- 4 Press  or  to choose the mode. Press **OK**.



- 5 Press **Stop/Exit**.

PABX (PBX) and TRANSFER

The machine is initially set to Normal, which lets the machine connect to a standard PSTN (Public Switched Telephone Network) line. However, many offices use a central telephone system or Private Automatic Branch Exchange (PABX). Your machine can be connected to most types of PABX (PBX). The machine's recall feature supports timed break recall only (TBR). TBR will work with most PABX (PBX) systems allowing you to gain access to an outside line, or transfer calls to another extension. The feature works when **Tel/R** is pressed.

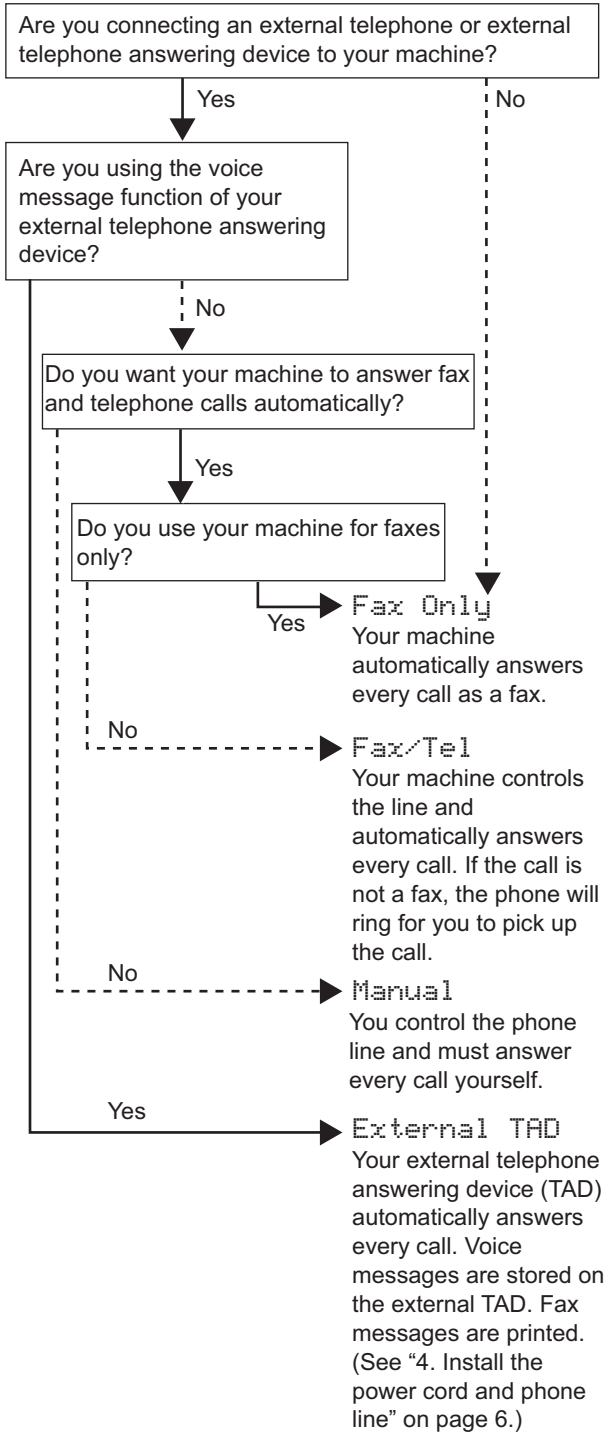
Note



You can program a **Tel/R** key press as part of a number stored in a One-Touch or Speed-Dial location. When programming the One-Touch or Speed-Dial number (**Menu, 2, 3, 1** or **2, 3, 2**) press **Tel/R** first (the screen displays "!"), then enter the telephone number. If you do this, you do not need to press **Tel/R** each time before you dial using a One-Touch or Speed-Dial location. (See "Storing numbers" in Chapter 8 of the User's Guide.) However, if PBX is not selected in the Phone Line Type setting, you cannot use the One-Touch or Speed-Dial number that **Tel/R** press is programmed into.

9 Selecting a receive mode

There are four possible receive modes: Fax Only, Fax/Tel, Manual and External TAD.

Choose the Receive Mode which best suits your needs.





- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press **0**.
- 3 Press **1**.
- 4 Press  or  to select the mode. Press **OK**.
- 5 Press **Stop/Exit**.

10 Setting the LCD contrast

You can change the contrast to help the LCD look lighter or darker.

- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press **1**.
- 3 Press **8**.
- 4 Press  to increase the contrast.

WPA-PSK enables a Protected Access Pre-shared key that allows the Brother wireless machine to associate with access points using TKIP and AES encryption. WPA-PSK uses a Pre-Shared Key that is more than 7 and less than 64 characters in length. See Chapter 3 of the Network User's Guide for more details.

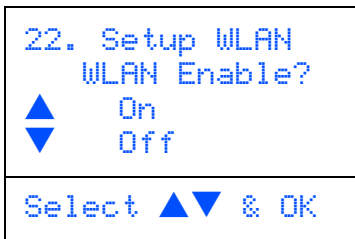
- 2** Plug in the power cord and turn on the machine.



⊘ Improper Setup

If you have previously configured the wireless settings of the machine you must reset the network (LAN) settings before you can configure the wireless settings again. Press Menu, 6, 2, 4 (or Menu, 6, 0) and then press 1 to accept the change.

- 3** On your machine, press **Menu, 6, 2, 2, 1**.



Press or to choose On (or Off), then press **OK**. The wired network interface will become inactive with this setting.

- 4** The machine will search for available SSIDs. If a list of SSIDs is displayed, use the or keys to choose the SSID you wrote down in step 1, then press **OK**. Go to step 8.

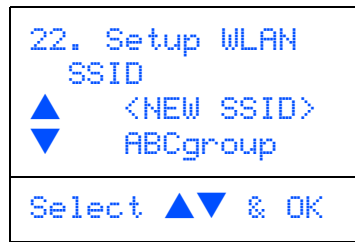

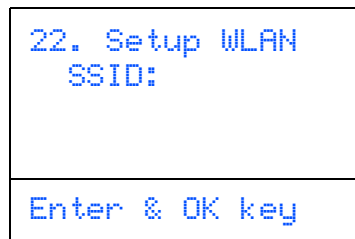
It will take a few tens of seconds to display a list of available SSIDs.

If your access point is set to not broadcast the SSID you will have to manually add the SSID name. Go to step 5.

- 5** Select `<NEW SSID>` using or and press **OK**. Go to step 6.



- 6** Enter the SSID you wrote down in step 1. For information how to type text, see “Entering Text” in Chapter D of the User’s Guide.



- 7** Press or to choose `Infrastructure`, then press **OK**.

- 8** Use the , and **OK** keys to choose one of the options below: If your network is configured for Authentication and Encryption you must match the settings used for your network.

No Authentication or Encryption: Choose `Open system`, press **OK** then choose `None` for `Encryption Type` and press **OK**. Then press or to choose `1.Yes` and press **OK** to apply your settings. Go to step 12.

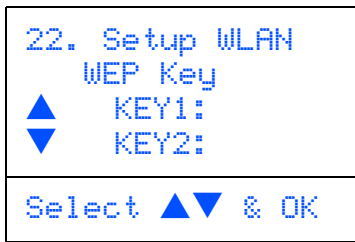
No Authentication with WEP Encryption: Choose `Open system`, press **OK** then use the or to choose `WEP` for the `Encryption Type` and press **OK**. Go to step 9.

Authentication with WEP Encryption: Choose `Shared Key`, press **OK**. Go to step 9.

Authentication with WPA-PSK (TKIP or AES Encryption): Choose `WPA/WPA2-PSK`, press **OK**. Go to step 10.

Authentication with LEAP: Choose `LEAP`, press **OK**. Go to step 11.

- 9** Choose the appropriate key number and press **OK**.



Enter the WEP key you wrote down in step 1 using the dial pad. You can use the and keys to move the cursor. For example, to enter the letter a, press the 2 key on the dial pad once. To enter the number 3, press the 3 key on the dial pad seven times. The letters appear in this order: lower case, upper case, numbers and then special letters.

Press **OK** when you have entered all the characters, then choose 1. *Yes* and press **OK** to apply your settings. Go to step 12.

Most access points and routers can store more than one key, but they will only use one at any time for authentication and encryption.

- 10** Press or to choose TKIP or AES for *Encryption Type* and press **OK**. Enter the WPA-PSK Pass you wrote down in step 1 using the dial pad. You can use the and keys to move the cursor. For example, to enter the letter a, press the 2 key on the dial pad once. To enter the number 3, press the 3 key on your dial pad seven times.

Press **OK** when you have entered all the characters, then choose 1. *Yes* and press **OK** to apply your settings. Go to step 12.

- 11** Enter the user and press **OK**. You can use and keys to move the cursor. For example, to enter the letter a, press the 2 key on the dial pad once.

Enter the password and press **OK**, and then choose 1. *Yes* and press **OK** to apply your settings. Go to step 12.

- 12** Your machine will now try to connect to your wireless network using the information you have entered. If successful, *Connected* will appear briefly on the LCD.

Connection Error is displayed when the print server has not successfully connected to your router or access point. Try starting from step 3 again. If the same message is displayed again, reset the print server back to the default factory settings and try again. (See *Restoring the network settings to factory default* on page 53.)

- 13** The machine will automatically acquire the correct TCP/IP address information from your access point (router) if DHCP is enabled (DHCP is normally enabled as default for most access point routers).

If your access point does not have DHCP enabled you will need to manually configure the IP address, subnet mask and gateway of the machine to suit your network. See the Network User's Guide for details.

- Wireless setup is now complete. To install the MFL-Pro Software suite, continue to step 14.**

- 14** Turn on your Macintosh®.

- 15** Put the supplied CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.



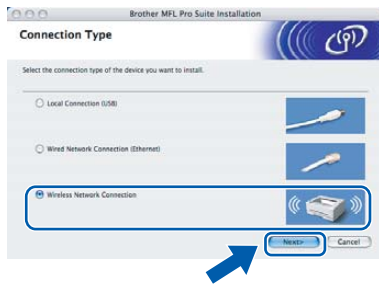



To restore all network settings of the internal Print/Scan server to factory default, please follow the steps below.



